Indian government has revised the National IPR policy in May 2016. The Union Cabinet approved the National Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Policy on 12th May, 2016. The Policy recognizes to foster creative and innovative energies that flow in India, and to channelize these energies towards a better and brighter future ahead. The National IPR Policy is a vision document that encompasses and brings to a single platform all IPRs. It views IPRs holistically, taking into account all inter-linkages and thus aims to create and exploit synergies between all forms of intellectual property (IP), concerned statutes and agencies. It sets in place an institutional mechanism for

implementation, monitoring and review. It aims to incorporate and adapt global best practices to the Indian scenario.

In this direction college initiated the formation of IPR Cell to encourage research and provide conducive environment to researchers. The IPR cell of the college aims to create awareness on IPR among the stakeholders of the Institution.
